RISK ASSESSMENT SHEET

Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. **PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors, visitors, campers, schools, public)
Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors
2. **POTENTIAL HAZARDS** (anything with the potential to cause harm)
 - a) Failure of user to follow instruction
 - b) Unmanaged power cables / fire
 - c) Failing to service/manage equipment, lack of training
 - d) Inclement weather
 - e) Uncontrolled groups, other site users
 - f) Incorrect loading / unloading of Spider Mountain
3. **ASSESSMENT OF RISK**

4. **LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS**
 - a) Instruct them how to slide safely and monitor, only one person on slide at a time, descend feet first. Only one person climbing wall at a time.
 - b) Ensure cables are kept away from users and correct equipment used. Generators if used, turned off when refilled.
 - c) Check daily and correct training in use. Daily operating checklist completed.
 - d) If the equipment becomes dangerous because of the weather conditions, stop immediately
 - e) Keep all groups away from any moving part and suitable barriers in place
 - f) Trained personnel only, follow manufacturers guidelines, suitable training
